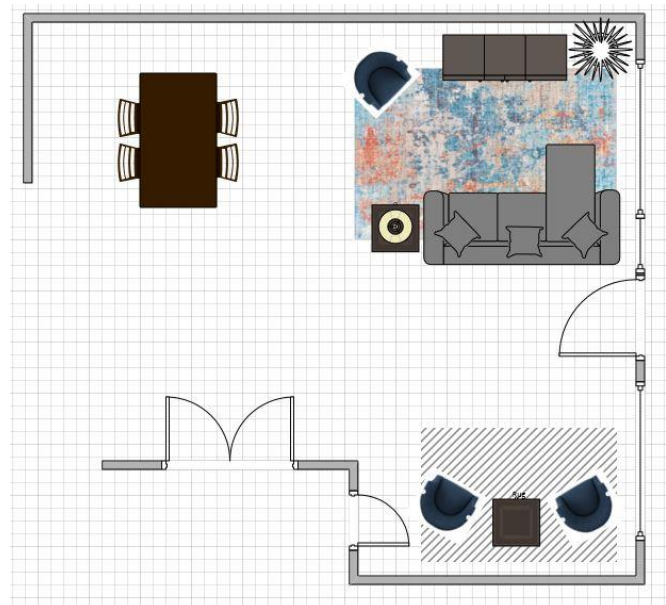
## Open Concept Rectangular Layout

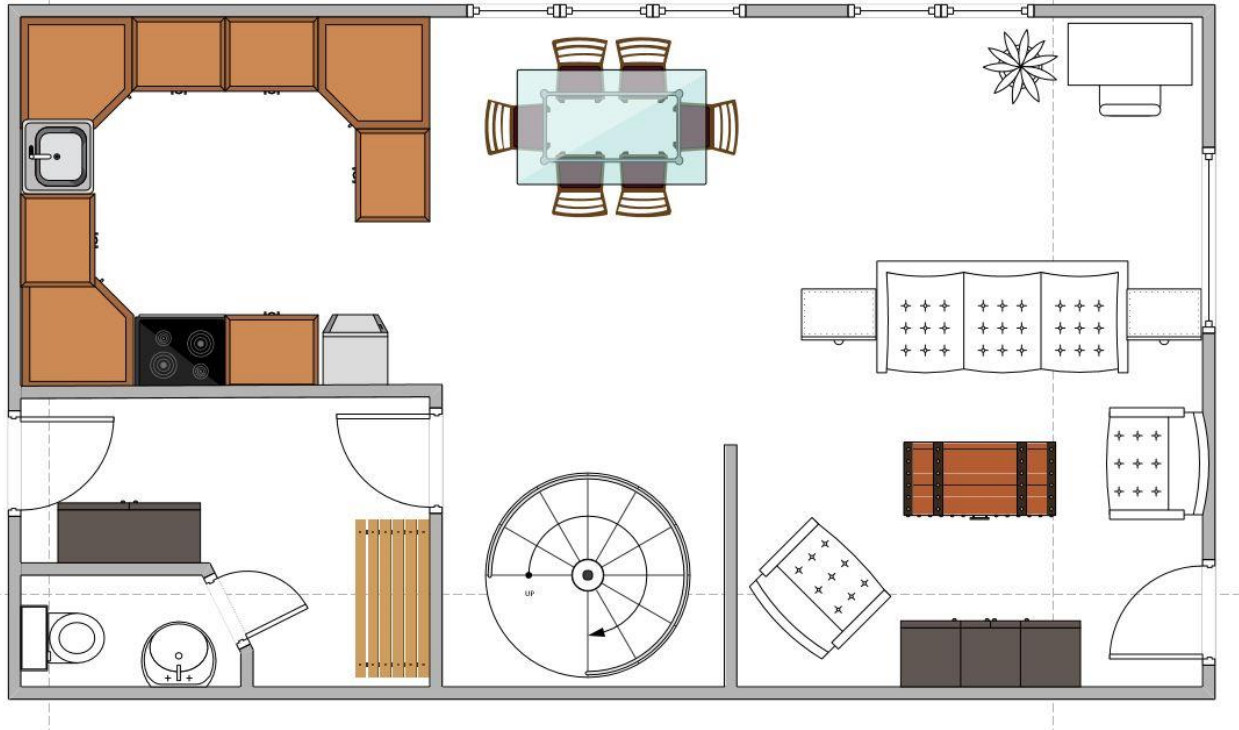


## Open Concept L-Shaped Room Layout
