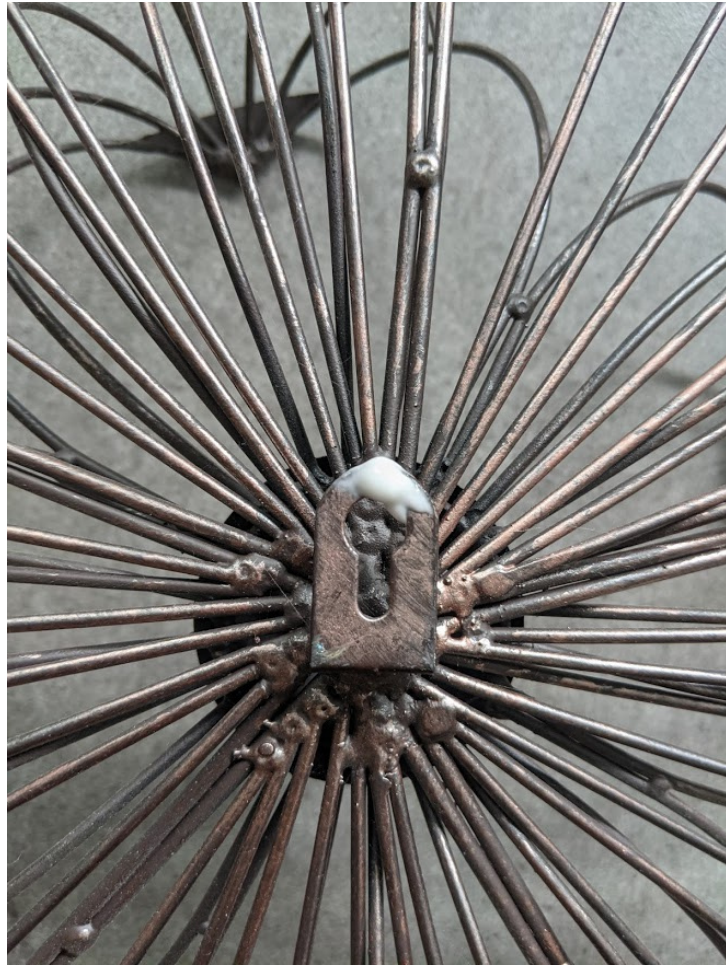
TOOLS/TIPS

1. Measuring tape
2. Laser level/torpedo level
3. Various nails/hangars
4. Blue tape
5. Kraft paper
6. Toothpaste
7. Hammer

Use wall anchors
for artwork
that is heavier than 10 lbs.



HOW TO USE TOOTHPASTE ON ART WORK



1. On the brackets, add a small dab of toothpaste
2. Press artwork against wall to leave a mark of toothpaste
3. Put nails in the spot of toothpaste
4. Wipe away toothpaste

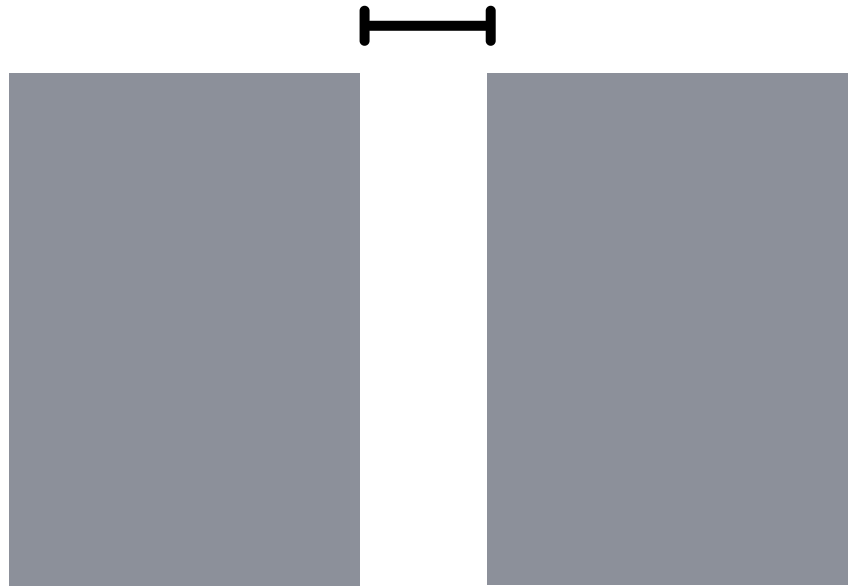
WALL CONFIGURATIONS



66 inches from floor to middle of art



Space between is no more than 1/2 width of art



If frames are 10 inches wide, the space between the two frames should be no more than 5 inches wide.



With adjacent walls, hang the smaller art piece so that it is centered on the bigger art piece





The "Rainbow effect"



Hang the art so that it arches in the middle like it does here to look like a rainbow.

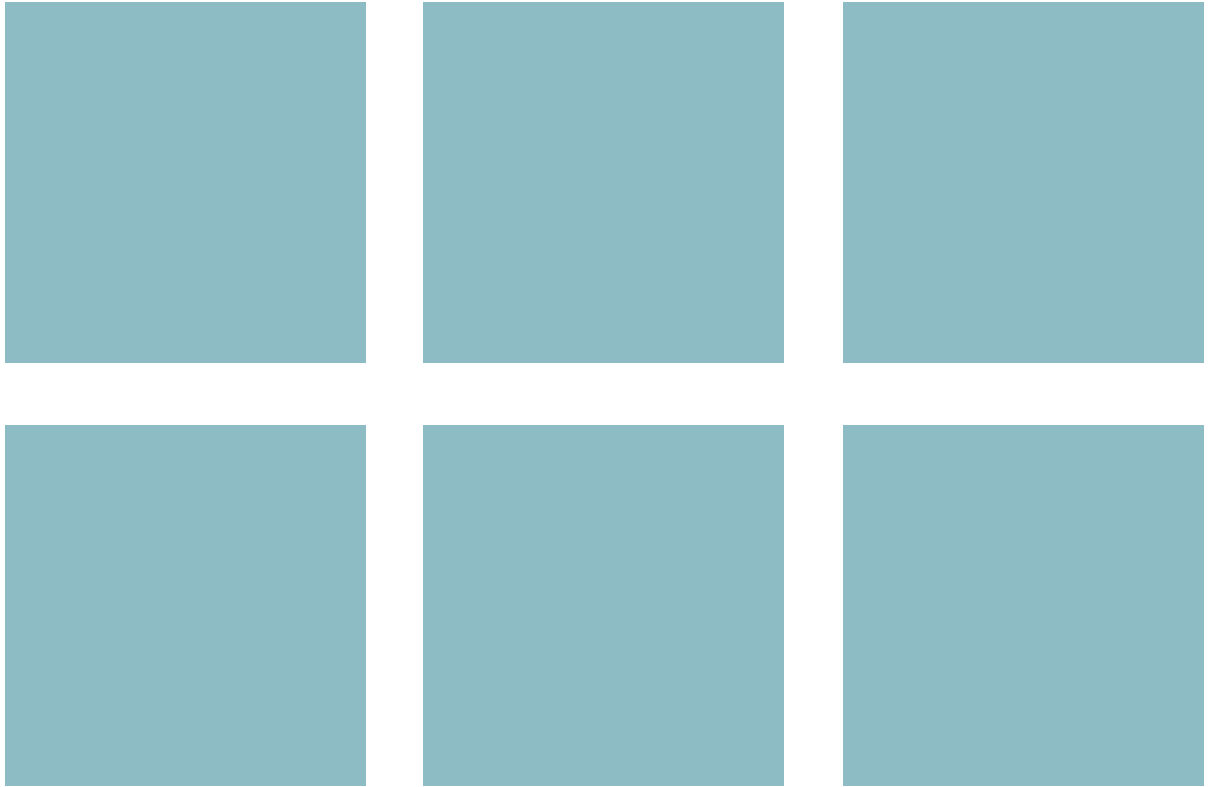
It is ok to have the middle art piece higher than the 2 on either side.



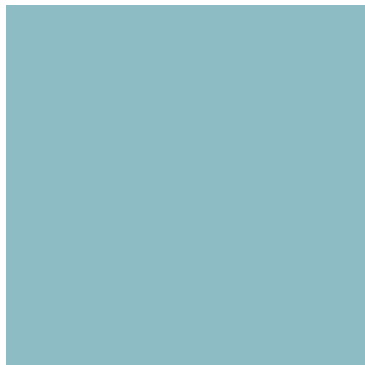
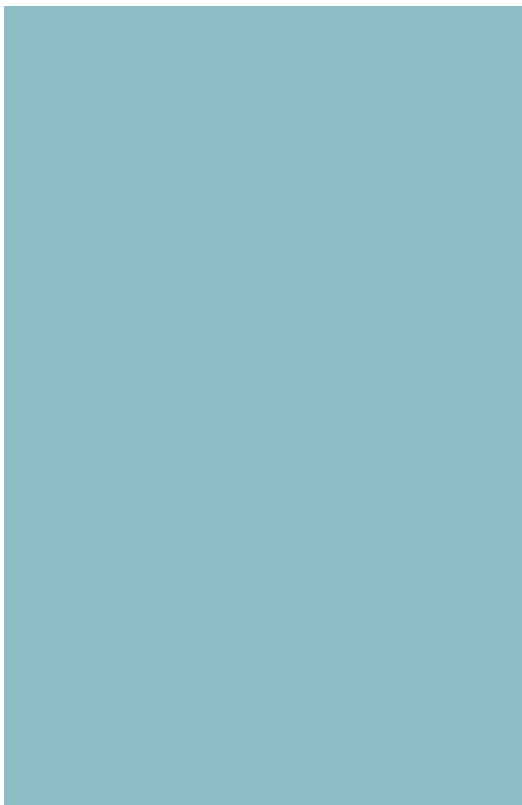
Make sure the art piece does not extend past the furniture piece.

Notice how all 3 wall art pieces are aligned at the top (laser level helps here).

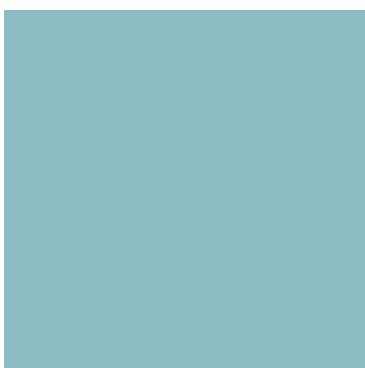
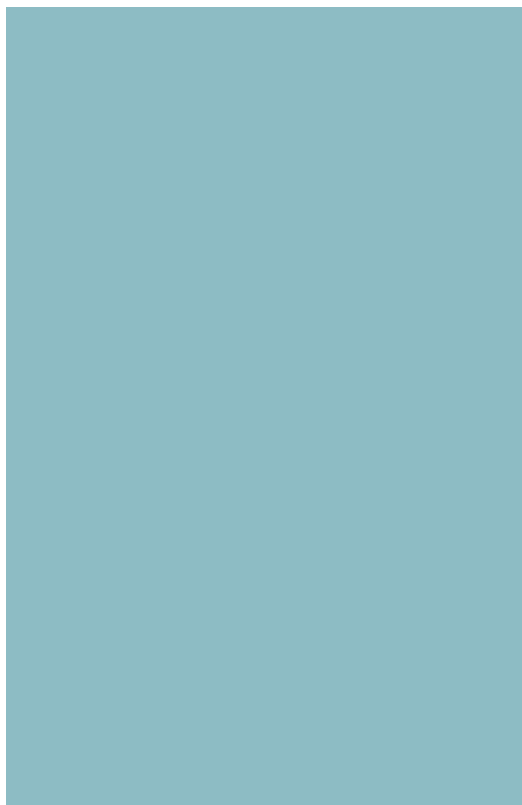
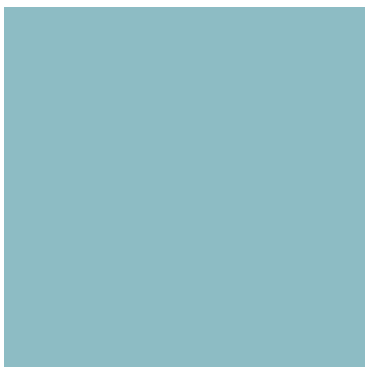

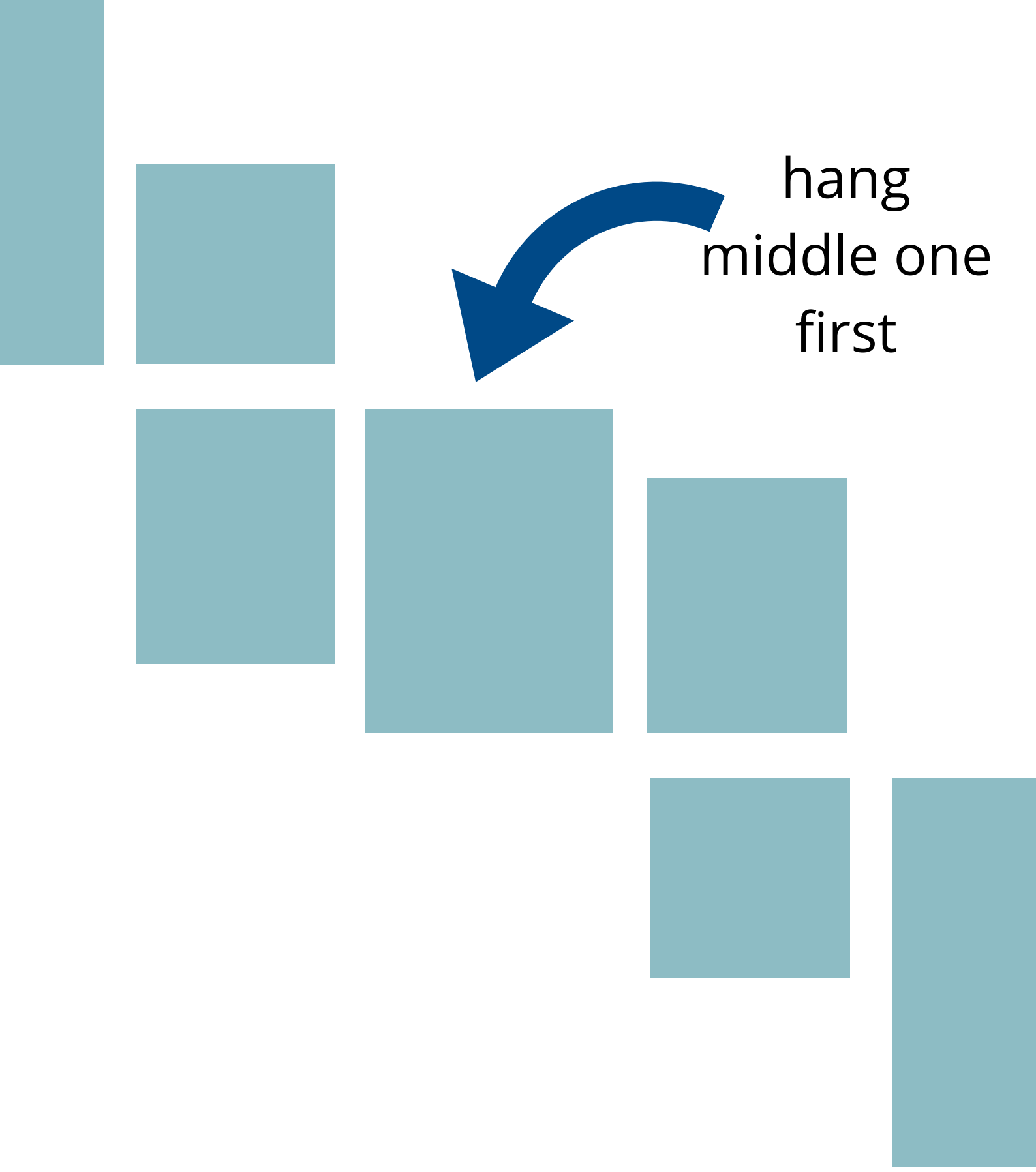
